ANTI-RAGGING POLICY

The anti-ragging policy of TBAKC was framed in accordance with the Judgment of the Supreme Court of India dated 08/05/2009 in a civil appeal case No. 887/2009 and as per the notification "Regulation on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions".

The Anti-Ragging Policy of the College

- Aims to make the Thassim Beevi Abdul Kader College and the HMBT hostel, a ragging menace free campus.
- Constitutes of an Anti Ragging Committee.

Anti-Ragging Committee:

According to the order of Supreme court and Ragavan Committee report, Anti-Ragging Committee and Anti-Ragging Squads are formed to curb the incident of ragging on the campus.

The Committee includes

- The Principal
- Dean of Arts & Sciences
- Heads of the Departments and
- Student Council Members

The Act of Ragging:

The following are considered as the act of ragging:

- Misconduct of any student either in spoken or written form or any action that has the effect of harming others.
- Indulging in indisciplinary activities that cause physical or psychological harm or fear or apprehension
- Asking others to do things that they normally will not do and causes a sense of shame or emotional embarrassment.
- Any act that disrupts the others academic activity by any senior student

- Financial extortion or forceful monetary burden on a fresher or any other student.

- Any act of abuse by spoken words, emails, posts, public insults to derive sadistic pleasure.
- Any act that affects the mental health and self confidence of any student with or without intent to derive sadistic pleasure or priority over others.

Role of Anti-Ragging Committee:

The following are the roles of the Anti-Ragging Committee:

- Creating awareness about ragging and ensuring a student-friendly environment at all times.
- Ensuring discipline by addressing students a clear message that any act of ragging shall not be tolerated and no act of ragging shall go unnoticed or unpunished.
- Keeping a continuous watch over ragging to prevent its occurrence and recurrence.

Functions of Anti-Ragging Committee:

Various necessary measures are taken to safeguard and protect the juniors and also to inculcate strong ethical values among the students with effect from 2010-11 onwards which are as follows:

- To obtain an undertaking by each student and her parents during admission to college.
- To update the college website with the complete address and contact details of members of the anti-ragging committee.
- To provide a clear warning on anti- ragging in the college's prospectus.
- To arrange for prominent display posters against anti-ragging warning in the college and hostel campuses to create awareness.

- Any affected student can send a sealed letter or email to the Principal containing a clear narration of the incident.
- Students complaints can be represented by their faculty
- Students' complaints can be represented by their parents or from the deputy wardens in case of hostel wardens.
- Students can call the helpline No: 1800 180 5522 and register their complaints.

Punishments for Ragging:

The Anti-Ragging committee will check any complaint on ragging and will recommend one or combination of the following punishments depending on the nature and gravity of the offence .

1. A FIR shall be lodged without exception by the college authorities with the local police.
2. Cancellation of admission.
3. Suspension from attending classes.
4. Withholding / withdrawing scholarship / fellowship and other benefits.
5. Debarring from appearing in any test / examination or other evaluation process.
6. Withholding results.
7. Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
8. Suspension / expulsion from the hostel.
9. Rustication from the institution for a period ranging from 1 to 4 semesters.
10. Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution.
11. Collective punishment: When the persons committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment as a deterrent to ensure community pressure on the potential raggars.
